- If customers can easily find out the exact cost of a product or there is no advanced technology or tax advantage- then there will be only a very remote possibility of satisfactory returns. Do not select that line for a new business.
- 2. Forget the old belief that "nothing is impossible". Be practical, if you want to do something extraordinary, check your efficiency, select a difficult and useful task, that you think can achieve, start, try again and again but never make it a prestige issue. If you think you cannot succeed, never be ashamed to accept your failure.
- Do not blindly copy or behave like other successful persons; study them carefully- there might have been reasons, inspiration, support or situations in their lives and careers that you may not know, cannot know, or have.
- 4. Do not run after and waste your time in trying to develop an intimate relationship with persons in authority, contacts or sources before you need them. If your all-round performance and behaviour remain good, then you will find them accessible when you really need them.
- 5. Progress is retarded by wrong decisions but right decisions require experience. Errors take place while evaluating your own experience. So always be ready to accept ideas from others, especially if it is not going to harm you in future.
- The nature of a person cannot be known only through discussions. Only dealings and performance reveal the truth. Be very careful while starting new dealings with anybody. Do not deal with strangers.

- Your intention should be to do business on the basis of merit only; always try to improve quality. Business done for glamour, or under pressure from any source, will not last.
- 8. While dealing with those in authority, respect, appreciate and understand their practical difficulties and try to cooperate. Be tolerant in conforming to their requirements. It will help to speed up your work and maintain your progress.
- 9. Select suppliers and personal contacts only among those who have a very good reputation in their dealings and are known for their impartiality. Make it a habit to deal in a logical and scientific way, rather than on blind faith, promises or assurances.
- 10. There is no substitute for long hours and sincere work.
- 11. Immediately recruit employees if you are too busy, and try to develop your employees' knowledge of the business.
- 12. Idleness is better than doing something in a hurry and without any experience.
- 13. If you are not gaining in any way by giving of your time to anyone, do not waste your time any more.
- 14. The benefit of the doubt should always be given to others, it will pay you in the long run. Allowing customers facilities which are not entirely justified will help you progress faster.
- 15. Do not take undue advantage of your better quality or service, you should always be reasonable compared with your competitors, it will keep you always ahead of them.

- 16. Your talents should always be utilized for the benefit of your customers. Confusing customers with your superior talents or cleverness will harm you in the long run.
- 17. Goods sold always must have worth; do not sell only on the faith of your customers in you.
- 18. Do not compromise anywhere, where your goodwill or image is likely to be tarnished; only a clean image will direct you towards a leading position.
- 19. Whenever you fail to prove the worth of your product, search for a scientific way to prove its worth. Science always helps to remove confusion about the worth of a product.
- 20. Spend as much money and time as you can in research and development, this will maintain your progress.
- 21. Libraries and literature are the best source for general information and help to develop business.
- 22. Make a habit to note down, immediately, any significant idea or thought that comes to mind, as you may not remember it later.
- 23. If the opportunity offers itself, it is very difficult for anyone to resist the temptation to misappropriate documents of particular interest to him. Therefore be careful to whom you entrust your confidential documents.
- 24. Stay clear of chamchas and sycophants. Always check on your image in the market. Do not try to silence your critics. Accept your weak points and try to remove them.
- 25. Anything gained in an easy way is always difficult to retain.

- 26. Do not earn money without earning goodwill at the same time. Your business conduct should be so fair that people should never regret having dealt with you.
- 27. Whether laws are justified or not, if you are forced to violate them for any reason, feel conscious of your guilt and try to minimize violating the law.
- 28. Minimize your differences with those in authority, against even an unreasonable approach. Only your patience and polite dealings will pay. Otherwise your progress will be hampered.
- 29. False promises always create problems.
- 30. Always be cooperative and tolerant in dealing with rich and influential or renowned persons. Carefully evaluate their comments.
- 31. Do not set yourself unrealistic business objectives. These may disturb your nature, cheerfulness, life-style, humour, etc. That may even retard your progress.
- 32. It is very difficult to follow all the rules in business.
- 33. You always have to remain alert. Business is not all smooth sailing. Situations never remain the same.
- 34. Always try to save more than fifty percent of what you earn. Most of the savings should be invested in your business. Do not lend your money. Money earned through interest will not give you experience and may retard your progress.
- 35. Whenever you meet a new supplier, ask him-politely-to prove that he can regularly supply the goods you need, at reasonable rates, and maintain quality and delivery

- schedules, better facilities and after-sales service. An honest supplier will always be happy to oblige. His buyback terms will indicate the value of his product.
- 36. Buy your requirements against immediate payment and from those manufacturers who buy their raw materials on a similar basis; have due regard for their knowledge of and experience in their line. If possible, provide raw materials or money in advance to the manufacturer to reduce your costs. If necessary, borrow money at a viable interest rate.
- 37. Sometimes you may not earn as much as you deserve, especially if you are in business in an area in which there is a lack of natural resources, inadequate infrastructure, or adverse political, social and family situations. Take wise steps favourable to you in these situations.
- 38. Always make an appointment and preparations before you visit anyone.
- 39. It is better to do a tiring, time-consuming and monotonous assignment by immediately taking the initiative, without a time bound programme, rather than by keeping it aside.
- 40. Do not hesitate to ask for help from your well-wishers. Do not expect or wait in hope that they will come forward to help you; sometimes, even a well-wisher will hesitate to cooperate with you on the assumption that you may unintentionally pass on his information to others, thereby causing him harm.
- 41. "Charity begins at home". Always follow this old saying. Before giving any help, first see to your home, relatives and your nearest and dearest. Charity always gives

fame, but fame gained through charity may create jealousy, and this fame creates hindrances in social and business relationships. So give charity or any help only to such extent and in such a manner as will not retard your progress.

- 42. Your polite, lenient or tolerant nature should never be misunderstood for weakness.
- 43. You should spend the maximum time in your business. Do not try to be an all-rounder. Do not worry if you are weak in general knowledge or if you are not well known in society.
- 44. Do not take too many risks in any of your dealings; this means you do not have sufficient experience. Collect information to reduce the risk.
- 45. Always be loyal, loyalty is more important than hard work.
- 46. Selection of the right persons makes life more pleasant and progressive, but it is a difficult task to select and retain them
- 47. Always be careful in new and unfamiliar situations.
- 48. You yourself know the steps you have to take for the solution to your own problems, but you often ignore them. You have to concentrate your mind, prepare yourself and determine to solve them.
- 49. There is no short cut to the straight path. Discuss matters in a natural and simple way. Misrepresentation will ultimately do you more harm than bring you gain.
- 50. Do not rely on anybody too much. Although you cannot work without trust, nobody can be one hundred percent

reliable in all situations. Situations never remain the same. So always keep some reservation in your mind, only doubt should not disturb your peace and progress. However, never show, or act on, suspicion without confirmation.

- 51. You should always compromise or sacrifice to some extent to end disputes with those whom you consider bad. Otherwise how you can consider yourself a good man?
- 52. Do not tell lies. In certain situations, speaking the truth may be harmful to you. These situations mostly arise while dealing with people in authority, competitors, and persons jealous or suspicious of you. There you may have to confuse or twist the situation.
- 53. Always honour your promises, except when your promise has been taken in a dishonest way, because of undue pressure, by creating confusion or by misrepresentation.
- 54. Never expect sudden gain or wealth without any effort otherwise it will disrupt your normal growth.
- 55. Do not hold any personal grudge towards anybody. Justified complaints should be put at the right time, through a proper channel.
- 56. Do not get disappointed or feel discouraged when you fail to achieve something: all significant developments have come about in spite of initial failures.
- 57. You may not be an exceptionally intelligent man, but do not let this deter you from attempting to do exceptional work.
- 58. Your success should always improve your behavior.

- 59. Be well-informed about your competitors' activities on all matters relevant to your business.
- 60. Do not take undue advantage of anybody. Taking advantage of those who are weak, or passing through a difficult situation, will ultimately harm you.
- 61. Your own love towards all human beings will give you peace and bring success in your life but showering it everywhere without discrimination will burden you.
- 62. During general discussions with anybody, always politely establish that you are his man, and that your knowledge and resources will be available to him on justifiable grounds, but do not leave a dominant image, a dominant image creates jealousy.
- 63. Ahot temperament always proves costly, a cool disposition will always pay you. A hot temperament is due to the nature of a person and it recedes only through his own experience and with time. So always try to learn more from the experience.
- 64. If you have had any bad experience in dealings with anybody, remember that, in the first place, it is your error in judgement in selecting him.

- 66. Greed spoils the value of wisdom and experience.
- 67. The most difficult task is to prove truth to be true. You will not enjoy the fruits of honesty and loyalty, if you cannot prove that you are honest and loyal.

- 68. Read, learn, listen and talk as much as you can, but the subject should be linked, directly or indirectly, with your progress.
- 69. Be loyal and never forget those who have given you their cooperation in the achievement of your goals or in any other respect.
- 70. Do not become too close to anybody unnecessarily; too much knowledge about others may disturb you.
- 71. Always try to take a harmonious decision convince or be convinced
- 72. Do not claim that you are always punctual.
- 73. Never claim that you are not a selfish man.
- 74. You should not deceive anybody. Try to ignore anybody by whom you have been deceived, or who has created problems for you. To neutralize a problem, concentrate your mind, work hard, think sincerely about the situation, be confident, have patience and believe that "Truth always prevails". The situation never remains the same. Continue your efforts till you overcome the problem.
- 75. Do not only listen, always speak freely, share your knowledge, and be always informative and helpful, but always with care that you should not reveal anything that can harm you in the future. If you do not share your knowledge, mature and experienced persons will not share their knowledge and cooperate with you.
- 76. You are a learner, you should also always learn from others' experiences and feel obliged towards those who share their experience with you. Do not hesitate to follow

good advice from anybody even if he himself does not follow it. For example, if a drinker or smoker advises you to refrain from these habits while himself indulging in them.

- 77. Refrain from bad habits. All bad habits hamper progress.
- 78. You should always try to be a good friend or well-wisher of others, but do not expect to have well-wishers yourself.
- 79. Be sure that your good behavior and sacrificing nature towards all will tide you over in all difficult situations. Do not regret those who went away when you needed them, forget the cooperation you extended to them in their times of difficulty.
- 80. Do not insult anybody.
- 81. Nobody can be one hundred percent impartial, but nobody can be impartial in all situations. Make your comments only when you are sure of your facts.
- 82. You cannot change anybody's nature or educate them immediately. Do not waste too much time in education, the nature of a person is only changed slowly, by his own experience.
- 83. If malicious rumours are being spread against you, reply only at a time favourable to you. Do not waste your time and disturb yourself unduly. Patience always reveals the truth.
- 84. If you do not get the attention you desire, try to find out the reasons; respect is achieved only through performance.
- 85. Do not take revenge; a desire to take revenge will always disturb you.

- 86. Friendship involving wide differences in status generally do not last.
- 87. Sometimes you cannot render justice, or have to tolerate injustice to end a dispute, or to avoid further complications. If, by virtue of your maturity, you tolerate an injustice, you should not be disheartened.
- 88. Do not regret any sacrifice you may have made. God will not remain indebted to you for your good deeds. He will give you internal strength, confidence, goodwill and thrusting force. Do not underestimate the value of sacrifice, it never goes in vain and it should be continuous throughout life.
- 89. Enter anybody's premises only as a well-wisher, do not unnecessarily go anywhere if you feel uncomfortable there.
- 90. Make personal friends to that extent only, where you can easily maintain your relationship with them. If you cannot give time to some of your old friends or acquaintances, give them the real reasons rather than ignore them altogether.

- 92. Sometimes too much respect gained through your social activities or giving too much time to them, may retard your progress.
- 93. Do not unnecessarily confront anti-socials, their roots are strong, and their survival is due to the fact that sometimes they provide instant justice.

- 94. Your abilities will not reward you as you deserve, if you underestimate the value of frankness, loyalty, morality, honesty, and sacrifice.
- 95. Every person has some special knowledge, so always try to learn from everybody. Show respect to, and discuss freely with, all types of persons, whether poor or rich, of any caste or creed, in business or profession, employee or owner, if you have any inclination to learn.
- 96. Always remain with progressive persons; get inspiration but never be jealous of them. Always appreciate and encourage a sincere approach, efforts or performance.
- 97. A sincere and energetic nature comparatively creates more jealousy, but sincerity compensates for everything
- 98. Never show pride. Always behave in a normal way, you are a creation of nature, you did not make yourself.
- 99. Always bring yourself to your listeners' level, and use simple examples.
- 100. Everyone like good principles, but often ignore them. So always remember and apply them at appropriate time.
- 101. Give ideas, rather than only monetary help, to others so that they may earn for themselves. Help only those who appreciate the value of help.
- 102. If your nearest or dearest is in any difficulty, your dedication to your business should not cause you to ignore him.
- 103. Make your life-style simpler than your status.
- 104. The right path is beset with obstacles. Patience is required to enjoy the fruits of your labour but do not hesitate to seek the right path.

- 105. Exceptions are always there, but most mistakes take place while evaluating exceptions.
- 106. If you want to achieve anything, you may have to lose something, usually those things, which you love most.
- 107. Sometimes too much self-control, discipline, etiquette, and simplicity may make you impractical.
- 108. To utilize your time properly, and to avoid complications, be sure that before you give too much respect, attention or time to anyone, he really is deserving of the same.
- 109. Before desiring anything be able to live without it. Otherwise you will always feel uncomfortable.
- 110. Even a very good-natured and principled person may not always behave in the manner you expect him to, due to his responsibilities or workload. Do not form a premature impression of him until you have studied the situation properly.
- 111. Do not comment on another's personal life-style, habits, nature, status, wisdom, etc. Unless you are very close to him. If you must comment, do so with extreme care. It will keep you out of controversy.

- 115. It is not necessary that you should always behave logically: where sentiment or the honour of the elders are affected, you should always be ready to compromise or sacrifice. Try not to hurt anybody's sentiments.
- 116. Always try to speak in another's language to the extent you know it; only those who lack commonsense speak in their favourite language, while knowing another's language.
- 117. Do not underestimate your efficiency. If you do not know or have adequate command over a particular language, your sincerity will compensate for everything. How many Germans or Japanese people know English? But they are well known for their progress. But you should always try to learn languages that you need.
- 118. Saying that "Morality is nothing but lack of opportunity" has no practical basis: would you prefer to develop business or relationships with an immoral, or with a moral, person?
- 119. If you want to be the leader in the product which you manufacture or in which you deal, provide the best possible quality, according to customers' requirements, error-free, fast and at the lowest cost, on a continuing basis. This requires tireless efforts, thorough knowledge of the product, goodwill, dedication, devotion, honesty, morality, loyalty, sacrifice, good behaviour towards all and a willingness to learn at all times. You cannot compromise on any aspect.

- 120. Always keep in mind, while reading any literature that situations are often so adverse for the writer that it is almost impossible for him to describe all his experiences in the manner he would actually like.
- 121. Religion, Duty, Truth, Justice, Experience and Work: all are the same. Religion says, "Do your duty"; Duty means doing justified work. Truth means justice; To do justice requires Experience; Experience is achieved when you work. God is the Supreme Experience of the universe. As it has been said, "Work is Worship"; to understand God you have to become master of your own work.

 - A good opportunity will never click without passion or a suitable situation.
- 46. He is formal with his friends.
 - Friends always frankly discuss even on their sensitive matters. So if he is formal all the time then the friendship is not ripened.
- 47. He is least suffocated with the corrupt system.
 - If one believes that most of the politicians to police, media to preachers, bureaucrats to professionals have

- first priority to work for their own interest than for others, then one is least suffocated.
- 48. He is managing the inefficient people but has to work extremely hard to make the business viable.
 - He is exhausting his energy. It is foolish to work with the useless people, if there is no compulsion.
- 49. He would easily talk to strangers and one day he met a stranger who gave him a business tip by which he made his fortune.
 - It was his luck. Another may lose his fortune by dealing with a stranger.
- The children are innocent.
 - The people of all ages are innocent in the aspects where they are inexperienced. Modern and young people think that elders are innocent.
- 51. He is facing repercussions of his past mistakes but feels he is being victimised.
 - People do not realise or accept the truth rather they become cynic.
- 52. He is blunt, short tempered and always behaves in his natural way. It is not wise.
 - But it also reflects his transparency. Sometimes these types of people get the most trusted assignment.
- 53. He is sharp but he failed to learn from his trainer. Everyone blamed that he did not learn sincerely. Later it was revealed that the trainer did not bring himself to the learner's level.
 - Sometimes mind remains biased on observations.

- 54. He does not like him because he is too suave.
 - In the informal relations too suave ones are generally unacceptable, as in the same way a blunt is unacceptable in formal relations.
- 55. He never agrees his mistakes rather gives endless logics.
 - Even many of the most dreaded criminals had never agreed at times that they were wrong, Time had only proved them wrong and shown them their way.
- 56. The late risers are always blamed, though they may sleep for same hours like the early risers. Their career routine may require it.
 - Many times the truth does not remain visible on the surface. It requires an in-depth knowledge to find it.
- 57. The orthodox father had educated his daughter and had instilled his family's old culture and values well in her. Later the situation compelled her to work in the modern office atmosphere and culture.
 - The earning compulsions change the culture.
- 58. The people are nature's creation: they may be good to bad. When and who will come in your close contact, you do not know.
 - You may improve a bad one but cannot change an apple into a mango. Alertness may make invulnerable.
- 59. Some people never accept their inability rather they blame others.
 - They may not be pretending but they really feel that they are efficient but people are obstructing their way.

- 60. He is a very good person, never creates problems to others but very often people make him land in the problems.
 - If one is good, it does not mean that he can lead an easy life. The people who want easy money or snatch others' rights will come to trap, malign, grab or betray him. A good person has to be also alert.
- 61. In the old days the elders would accept even the request, as the verdict of their elders but the new generation is different.
 - The new generation's upbringing and outside exposure is different than their elders, they need the reasons behind everything before they agree.

 - What will happen, if there are many prime ministers in a country with equal powers? No decision will take place. In the same way in an organisation, if many decision makers exist and everyone feels himself right and perfect. Then right leader is rarely chosen at the right time. That's why most of the business units and families went astray.

- 65. He is not happy of himself.
 - A philosopher cannot be an engineer and an engineer cannot be a doctor and they all cannot be what you are. Appreciating others is a quality but knowing your own speciality compared to others and remaining happy with whatever you are, is wisdom.
- 66. He is a righteous and virtuous person. But he meets with all types of people. People always raise question about him
 - It may be his simplicity or the reasons but the truth is not so important than what the people realize. One has to take care of his image otherwise one has to suffer.
- 67. His compounder said that he knows everything about the medicine
 - A Nobel Prize winner in the medicine said that he had just begun. The more one knows the world, the more one becomes calm, humble and feels himself insignificant.
- 68. He is right, wise but feeling alone and has become the victim of conspiracies.
 - Though he may be full of merits but if one does not make his social circle then he has to suffer in the difficult times.
- 69. He lived many years in a corrupt country but could not understand the country's system.
 - One has to enter in the country's topmost inner circle and one will find there that the majority of success stories, media reports, friendships and enmities were masks and the giants were busy in making people fools.

- 70. He always feels right and creates problems.
 - Everyone feels himself right but a few people want to establish themselves absolutely right. They feel that they are able to diffuse their errors, also underrate others and want all at their own terms. They are the most problematic people.
- 71. How can everyone like him and can meet him? But he makes personal relations very carefully.
 - Everyone has specific merits. He sees only merit in others and appreciates truthfully. That is why everyone likes him. Going deeper or seeing demerits helps only when one has to go closer to him for any reason.
- 72. He is very honest, wise, co-operative and practical but he has a very little circle.
 - Fire can mix with fire, water with water but fire and water fight till they can. In the same way the honest can mix with the honest that is why his circle has to be limited. The dishonest cannot stand before the honest for along time.
- 73. The hard work without honesty and both honesty and hard work without loyalty is redundant but why the word loyalty is not so popular like honesty and hard work?

 - At that point the lineage and his community are most important. Only the merits at that point are not so important.
- 78. Why does nobody like him?
 - He has all the problematic qualities. He is self-centred, short-sighted, selfish, uncreative, stubborn, does not care for society, megalomaniac, arrogant, unreachable, impulsive, careless...
- 79. How to judge one's act or action right or wrong?
 - If present and future effects of one's any action are pleasant to him and at least the majority of the affected people like it then it may be right.
- 80. He is brilliant but people around him are suffocating him out of jealousy.
 - Water sits on its level. It is nature. It may take time but he will finally reach where he really deserves.

- 81. He says still he has not understood, how to define the culture?
 - Since the primitive age, the definition of culture had never been defined nor can be. It changes according to time, need, compulsions and place.
- 82. Since hundreds of years one is used to learn the good principles on the way of life and also preaches others but he himself forgets to apply at the right time and shows his true nature.
 - This is the character of human nature.
- 83. What do you mean by society?
 - Society does not mean only the relatives or the community; it also means the circle in which one moves or the people who are affected by one's actions in his day-to-day life.
- 84. When the seniors rule the juniors then the juniors blame of depriving of their rights but when the seniors become liberal, juniors forget their duties and then a day either of them will create problem or be in problem.
 - The balancing situation remains only when the luck is good.
- 85. When situations are favourable then anyone can do anything as he likes but if he begins to think that all is due to his merits then in future he will have to face troubles.
 - Most of the people think so.
- 86. The crooks trap people by luring the people for what they desperately desire. Everyone knows it well and may

remain alert enough but still everyday people are trapped in the same way.

- This is life.
- 87. One worked hard, saved money, bought the right land, sowed the seeds, took care of it till the fruits grew. Later one day someone else forcefully grabbed the land. Now he enjoys the fruits, forgets the creator and takes the merit of its creation.
 - Why one should create anything which one cannot protect and keep safely?
- 88. He makes mistakes and promises not to make it in future but again makes it in the new situation.
 - It is natural to make mistakes in the new situation but it is important to ignore the past errors and carry the experience with him and remain alert.
- 89. Where there is glamour of any kind, a coterie of people is formed around it
 - The glamour of wealth, power, success, personality or goodness etc. form a coterie of people that try to create the barriers for better people to get in there easily. This is a curse on glamour.
- 90. No one meets him now because now he is powerless and old
 - The people recognize one only when, if one has wealth or knowledge, lineage or any type of glamour that can help one to get wealth or pleasure, otherwise one is ignored.
- 91. When a genius dedicates himself in a creation then most

of the people around him make fun of him.

- A creator has to concentrate and dedicate his mind. Thus he has to ignore many of his duties but by ignoring this, he is blamed even by his own people but when he succeeds then all want to share the fruits of his achievements.
- 92. A rare one can create and boost, a very few can nurture and preserve. Most of the people reap and enjoy but no one feels less than a creator.
 - Only a creator can truly realize the worth of another creator.
- 93. An old man always distributed candies to the children. Once he did not come. Then the children went to his house and shouted: Why did not you come? Old man: I am ill today.
 - Most of the people take nice people for granted.
- 94. No body knows what to do when the uncertainty surmounts, one becomes helpless, panicked, nervous and then the luck becomes their only hope.
 - Then the only way remains, be calm, try to accept the destined the none would be a bit relaxed.
- 95. Some people refrain from vices because it will hamper their progress while a few like the vices and exploit the powerful people for their progress.
 - It is most difficult to judge who is wrong or right when the progress is the only motive. Amazingly people of both the classes have made and retained the fortunes.
- 96. Most of the friendships have masks.
 - Amazingly basis of most friendships are social, financial

gains, security, personal interests etc. The more one has hope from the other, the more strong friendship will be but when the hope ends, the friendship also generally does not last.

- 97. He genuinely helped others by going out of the way and for the cause of humanity but the controversies emerged on the intention of help.

- 100. At the time of delegating the work to his juniors he forgets their capacity and level. Later he scolds them for their non-performance.
 - It is his inefficiency and thus he suffocates himself.
- 101. Anything said in excitement, anger, sadness, exhilarating moods should not be given importance.
 - But most of the times the said words at those times become a major matter of dispute.

- 102. He is young and does not feel the true extent of pain even of his mother.
 - One realises in his time, when he or anyone whom he loves the most, suffers the similar trauma.
- 103. He sometimes makes people angry purposely by maligning their self-respect and merits falsely.
 - He may want to irritate people to get something revealed from them that he wants.
- 104. Suggest a perfect idea even to your best friend, instead of appreciating it, he will tell its negative points first.
 - It is human nature to react reversely. Only a few are exceptions.
- 105. He is adamant and the logics, advices, requests, orders of close ones and the social pressure are not working.
 - Then believe in the destiny. A few are so born.
- 106. He was very talkative but nowadays he is becoming stoical.
 - The more one experiences and understands the world and becomes mature, the more he becomes reserved and stoical. He knows that things will continue to happen so.
- 107. The powers are given to the society, well-wishers or to the guardians even for their own children or the dependents for their welfare and not for their exploitation.
 - This is the fact but a very few realise.
- 108. A son insulted his father and said: I am sure and right in the matter and I don't care for anything. The father

somehow covered up the matter but one day he did the same to someone else, he beat him up and said: I am not your father to spare you.

- Time teaches the lessons.
- 109. He says that people are not good so he is depressed.
 - There are people from good to bad. Who comes early or later in life is the nature and luck. Life cannot be predicted easily.
- 110. He helped someone but it was late. So it went in vain.
 - Everyone knows that the help done on the requester's convenient time, gives a very good image while the same on the provider's time lessen its value but a very few realise it.
- 111. I have seen even crooks around famous people.
 - One may be in the contact of good or bad people for many reasons but the wise knows what he has to learn from him and how to use the one at the right time. The scientist had utilized even poisons as the base of most of the vaccines.
- 112. He is practical and moves in different societies but sometimes he is tagged as an uncultured person.
 - Everyone feels himself cultured but no one can learn all the cultures of all the segments of societies. Well-cultured one may be tagged as uncultured in a society where he is new.
- 113. When all are adamant and the dispute reaches at the peak then most of the times the wise compromises.
 - Because he is confident of his performance.

- 114. He is behaving surprisingly, unexpectedly or unnaturally, his logics do not seem to be convincing.
 - If he does not seem to divulge the actual reasons then be sure, the problem cannot be solved easily without knowing the actual reasons.
- 115. He is mature and wise but sometimes becomes furious when he faces anything nonsense or disrespect.
 - The maturity does not mean only the knowledge etc. but its timely application and also to what extent one can tolerate the nonsense, injustice, disrespect etc. wisely and then rebound the situation in own favourable time to a justified level.
- 116. Those who are instilled with the values and ethics and always help others out of their goodness but a few people feel that they were smart enough to motivate them to get the work done.
 - No one can read people's mind fully.

 - Many people who are in power do not have regards for values.
- 118. He looks very smart and intelligent but he has not transformed it into wealth or fame.

- 119. A fraudulent promised, agreed and signed an agreement that he will abide by it but he finally ditched.
 - Whatever the fraudulent one may agree but he never remains silent, he will always remain busy to find a new way to trap and at any moment he may twist, confuse and somersault the situation.
- 120. He is adamant. None can change him and expect the solution but it is essential to make him agree.
 - Anyhow remain in touch with him. Politely and discreetly knock him in his favourable time. Be his yes man at right time, you may get the result slowly.
- 121. He is most honest and reliable but I doubt that he had copied a few sensitive papers of mine.
 - Many may not steal the wealth but if there is a safe opportunity then only an exceptionally honest can resist the temptation of copying the sensitive information of his interest.
- 122. I never understood it that why he is antagonist of me.
 - Most successful sociologists, psychologists, wise and famous people were unable to keep happy even all the people around them. What an average one can expect from him.
- 123. He instantly admits his mistakes publicly.
 - A creative and practical person will immediately admit his mistakes while most of the people will seldom do it rather they will try to defuse with several ifs and buts.
- 124. The kids would tell lies to avoid the immediate problems, as they lack sharp mind and words. A habit goes down

- but remains there to some extent till one is alive. A very few never tell lie but may smartly confuse the situation.
- Life's best mental luxury is that if one can remain without telling lies.
- 125. He gains others faith or friendship very fast by behaving according to other's nature and fulfilling their necessities.
 - But it may not last for long, if his nature and situation do not match.
- 126. Does one's nature rule the mind?
 - The nature reacts first than the mind but the mind begins to dominate those aspects where one has experience. Elsewhere one's nature rules the mind.
- 127. Why most of the famous peoples' children did not become even popular though many may have been competent.
 - Probably the lives of most famous people had remained very busy so they were bound to ignore educating the children in their way at their proper time.
- 128. Often the wise fails to convince the powerful arrogant people.
 - Though sycophants are frivolous but sometimes they may break the ice by flattering and by fun and frolics. Sometimes the mighty fails, the trifle wins.
- 129. There are plenty of people who have talent, loyalty, honesty, education and they work hard also but get limited success only.
 - Perseverance and opportunities play the key role to get noticeable success. The opportunity falls more often

before strong and rich lineage.

- 130. How to catch a swindler who always presents himself carefully?
 - Incite and compel the doubtful person to talk more and more constantly. Listen to him patiently but do not commit to him anything. The swindler may be caught by the discrepancy in his said words.
- 131. He meets many people everyday but always remains confused in judging the people.

- 135. Do the law abiders always win?
 - Sometimes one may have to violate the laws but one calculates the cost of penalty or loss.
- 136. The prosperity is vulnerable to vices. Many rich people argue that their vices re-energize them and the cost of vices is also affordable to them.
 - But the time consumed by the vices, is highly expensive compared to the cost of vices and it may finally lead them astray.
- 137. How to become problem free?
 - The air may contain bacteria, virus etc. along with oxygen and one has to inhale it. In the same way one has to meet different people but one may remain safe by his wisdom. Else is destined.
- 138. He has authority and is capable but does not help others because he is always sceptical and cares too much for his image. He hesitates to help even the worthy people.
 - Then a day will come when he himself will be worthless in the society.
- 139. A truthful and a brilliant person became a lawyer but he failed in the court. Later he joined another office and his boss ordered him to tell lies to his clients but he resigned.
 - So only the boss or an owner may retain his own virtues.
- 140. How do people become billionaire?
 - Hypothetically, a satellite started searching for the persons who have earned for themselves and became

billionaires without violating the laws and using muscle power, strong patronage and political clout but the search ended with....Not found.

- 141. Once one failed to achieve a goal and the goal slowly lost its importance but his mind always intermittently craved to achieve the goal.
 - Because its achievement proves his capability to achieve it.
- 142. All are very intelligent but still not able to resolve the issue.
 - Where arguers are updated, strong, witty and even the issue may be critical but their talent will be measured by how fast they can resolve the issue without lingering it on.
- 143. To get pleasure at least for a while he gets surrounded by flatterers, sycophants, less affluent than him, who can act as he likes, scolds juniors, flaunts bossism and avoids facing difficult people.
 - It is an usual practice by most of the people to feel pleasure.
- 144. He was a trivial political worker but how come he became so rich?
 - He would first create problems for the rich then dissolve the problems in connivance with politicians and finally became a political leader and a rich person.
- 145. He often gives more attention to his friends than his relatives.
 - The relatives are always there by defaults while the friends are according to his nature and choice.

- 146. A salesman memorized many sales books and literature but failed in business.
 - The experience instilled in mind and one's nature instantly acts at the time of the sales and not what he has read in the books. Otherwise people with very good memory had only been successful.
- 147. He is always over confident and has a habit of covering up his mistakes and confuses others while realizing himself always right. He never changes his attitude.
 - Finally he will be found secluded and depressed.

148. What is luck?

- After completing studies, one out of two energetic friends got better marks and became a lecturer immediately, another who got less marks became a PA of a local Member of Parliament while wandering. After some time he became a power broker and finally an industrialist but the other one only remained a professor. This situation and career direction is called luck.

- 150. Why do you do selfless acts and go out of the way to help others and raise controversies?
 - It is my nature. It gives me happiness. Those who do it can only feel this happiness. Though people may doubt about my intention.

- 151. A kitten bit the tail of a very sick and old lion but the lion could not move due to his weakness. Then the kitten roared before the lion: You are a liar, you have never been strong.
 - This happens and this is life.
- 152. A kid to papa: Why cannot you do anything for me in your office like mummy does for me at home. She cares for me, gives me toys and does my homework? But papa kept mum.
 - Like the kid, one cannot learn many aspects of life before a certain time.
- 153. His wife often argues strongly with her husband and says that she does not want only money but he should stay more at home and enjoy a better quality of life but he always ignores as he can't do that.
 - Anywhere if there is freedom of expression then inner voice comes out naturally.
- 154. Why did his friend create unexpected distance from him?
 - You cannot predict till you know one's hidden agenda or his possessiveness for some things, you may have touched his possessive or sensitive issues.

 - Sometimes some situations make even brilliant people helpless.
- 163. He says that he is enough wise now and will remain always alert and swears that he would never repeat his mistake in misjudging a new person.

 - Only heartless ones can do so. Sometimes hypocritical polite words hurt and it becomes impossible to bear.

 - It is not so. Whenever I stepped up, it was a triumph.

If one falls from his good time then the striving to get it again, is called struggle.

- 180. You do not challenge anyone.

To deliver judgement according to the laws of God is justice. The laws of land are the media to deliver justice to human beings. Knowing the laws of God is truth.

Actions of God: The laws of God apply to each and every action or particle of this Universe. The laws are so vast that the volume of the Universe will be too small to keep it, if these are written at readable level to human beings. Probably that is why God Himself has not written His laws or given it to creatures.

Every action in this universe has its relevance and consequences. It may be a reward or a punishment or both according to the gravity of your acts but are fixed by the laws of God. If you have insulted anyone without any reason then only the sufferer can forgive you. You may spend money in millions for social welfares or do anything to please God but He will never interfere in it. Though God will give you rewards for your social welfares but account for your every act is different in the laws of God.

Influence on God: No one can cheat, bribe, purchase, influence or please God. He will never change His natural laws. God will never do any favour to anyone beyond His laws. Otherwise the rich or sages etc. would have purchased or controlled God. Whether you desire it or not, you will get fruits for your good deeds and suffer for your wrong deeds. Nobody, even God Himself will not interfere in it. This is the beauty of God, that is why we love him most and he will be loved most for ever.

Attachment & detachment: Religion says; Attachment or use of anything for more or less of any visible or invisible substance will harm you. To know the true amount of attachment or use of anything, it needs knowledge and applying it at right time. If you become excessive emotional, sentimental, dutiful, generous, kind etc. then you will suffer. Do excessive prayers, worship, reciting, chanting, hawan, donations, fasting, visiting holy places, you will also suffer.

Social welfares, prayers etc.: Is it then useless to do prayers, chanting, hawan, donations, social welfares, fasting, visiting holy places, religious austerity or confessions?

It may be useless, even worse or fruitful. It depends upon one's objective. If one's objective is to dilute one's sins than it may go in vain while with well-wishing of others may make one happier and prosperous.

Gurus: Who is a guru? A guru means from whom you learn. The religious preachers were only regarded as gurus before the scientific advancement or a few decades back. The lifestyle had almost been the same for thousands of years. There were limited subjects. So the religious preachers were only the gurus. In recent decades the nature played its part and since there had been tremendous scientific advancements that changed the earning aspects and lifestyle. The avenues of knowledge widened. People from every segment learnt more about the natural laws on contemporary subjects. So now a guru may be anyone, who has pursued to understand the laws of God or nature and has got experiences. These gurus may be your relatives, friends, scientists, psychologists, businessmen, religious preachers, professionals, or even market surveyors, your own servant or the nature itself etc. Everyone is guru. It lies in beholder's eye to find out of which subject one is guru. No individual can be a role model or adviser for all the subjects or problems. You have to select according to your particular objective. The genuine gurus know that an individual cannot understand all the relevant laws of God. All the religious literature will corroborate to it if one goes thoroughly.

That is why a genuine guru of any subject will never say that he knows everything about any subject that absolutely confirms to the laws of God. That is why a guru will never tell anyone to surrender to him, accept his dogmas or follow him blindly. He never binds you rather releases you. He will only tell you about his observations or experiences. If anyone says reverse to it then there is a trap. He is not your true well-wisher.

Observations and changes: Why the regular changes take place in observation of science, laws of land, way of doing justice, recognizing the truth, understanding the duty, explanations of religion etc.? The objective of all these is to follow the laws of

God. Once observers detect their error or whenever the truth is revealed, they have to change their observation. The laws of God are constant and will remain constant forever.

Goal: What should be your goal? Which should be the best suitable direction for you that can make your life happiest and prosperous? How will you decide it? This is the most difficult task for human beings. You are born in certain geographical location, family and social background or situation having limited approach and with fixed genes, talent, health, etc. Your first point of luck is where you had been conceived and the quality of mind or body that God had awarded you at that time. These situations are created by God. You did not make these situations and cannot change them. So it makes the situation so complex that it is impossible for you to choose the absolute best direction. This is the nature and only God knows the actual reason why he has made this world so perplexed. So one has to choose the goal, right person or direction by trial and error and this is the point of your luck.

Human actions: If you want to achieve a goal, an objective or take an action, you have to discover the natural laws relevant to your subject and act according to it. You have to consult the genuine gurus or experts of your relevant subject to understand these laws but one should never leave his mind or experience behind but always carry with him. Your duty is to learn or listen to all of them and then analyse the situation. Think neutrally and you will find your own way.

Anyone can be your guru or expert for a particular work. Guru doesn't mean that he is your all time adviser. He may be your one time guru for a particular work. It doesn't make any difference whether guru is rich, poor or a crook, if he can show you the right way for you. A crook may divulge a conspiracy against you

by others!

Religion: You may define the religion anyway or name it as you like. You may name it religion or xyz. It is the wisest "Way of Life" to make you happy and prosperous. All the laws of religion should corroborate with the law of nature. It includes the human behavioral science, psychology and philosophy. Most of us accepted it simply: The way of life. So it can not have fixed dogmas or definition, even definition has to change according to time to time and the situation. The objective of the religion is to show you the right way in any situation and to make you happy and prosperous by your own acts. This is the essence of religion.

What are the laws of religion? You have come in this present world and not in the heaven. So everything cannot be pleasant to you. You have to suffer to some extent. This is the nature, natural laws work. The religion shows the right way to lead your life with minimum sufferings. It accepts all truthful or justified acts, which are for the welfare of human beings. If you behave in a good or religious way toward others then you are not obliging others but doing it for yourself because you may get the same behavior from others that will award you an easier life.

Flexibility of religion: For example the religion is so scientific and practical that it allows wearing a dress physically and mentally comfortable to you at the sea beach but the same dress is disallowed in a public place in an orthodox village. In the same way whatever may be allowed to you to eat or drink in an isolated and remote area to survive where the essentials are not available but the same may not be allowed in a developed and cultured city or where the essentials are available. In both the examples the objective of religion is to keep you undisturbed and happy both mentally and physically.

Complexity of religion: The religion is so complex that it allows even wars at times. It seems a paradox that the religion allows even wars and to understand the reasons for it, you have to read the religious literatures thoroughly and then you will find the references of holy wars which had been fought for religious causes or to restore peace and justice to human beings.

In the religious literatures, there are abundant balanced messages or preaching for human beings but you may misinterpret isolated general messages of the religion, if you have not understood the religion thoroughly then these messages may not lead you to the true religious objectives. For example if you read only one clause of any legal act then you may miss the connected clauses of the act, thus you reach the truth partially and misinterpret the clause.

Religion applies for human beings only: The religious ways are for human beings and not meant for all the creatures. That is why it allows human beings to boil the food, inhale the air etc. for survival though these processes kill other creatures. This is verified by microscopes. The religious ways are scientific and based on human behaviour and psychology. It regulates human behaviour in such a way that it makes life more easy, pleasant and prosperous.

Simple shortcut formula to know religious acts: There is a very simple shortcut formula or a key to check whether your any act conforms to religion or not. Your act may be based on truth, justice, duty, work, virtues, tolerance, peace, non-violence, non-vengeance, denial, contentment, worship, devotion, dedication, meditation, reverence, love, care, humility, donations, forgiveness, pity, detachment, good preaching etc. or reverse to all these acts, or it may be based on your control on senses, emotions, sentiments, business or social decisions etc.

It may be your eating and dressing habits, lifestyle or personal likings, necessities or compulsions or it may be any act of seeing, listening, smelling, touching, eating, thinking, imagining or even fantasies. Filter your all these acts through following five questions to justify them according to the religion. If it is "yes" to all these questions then it conforms to the religion and it allows you to go ahead and make you happy. If anyone can check his act in this way then he will rarely need to go through voluminous religious books or reach the religious gurus.

Ask yourself:

- 1. Do the consequences of your any act that you are likely to do, would be pleasant to you?
- 2. Will its consequences also remain pleasant to you forever?
- 3. Will the *Most of the affected people and your society accept your act naturally or after explaining the situation well?
- 4. Will the consequences of your act not disturb the future generations?
- 5. Will the consequences of your act though even you may lie, will help to maintain peace, avoid conflicts or do justice to anyone and are not against the welfare of human beings?

*Why your act may be justified if the majority or most of the people accept it and may not unanimously? Because you cannot make everyone happy due to his unjustified self-interests, thus even if you achieve anything by your merit, dedicated efforts and in a wise manner, may also make many unhappy. For an example: if you achieve success in a virtuous manner, your competitors may be unhappy.

The religion also does not even accept any truthful act if its

consequences are against the welfare of human beings, disturb peace, create conflicts or do injustice to anyone. If a criminal hunts an innocent person and you save him by avoiding the truth, then it is an act that conforms to religion.

Human beings cannot perfectly act, but only God. Human beings will make errors. So if you have made errors then learn from them and always carry the experience with you.

If any religious, scientific or any other preaching does not conform to this system, it is a misinterpretation of the religion or laws of nature. Again if one has not prospered or is not leading an easier and happier life or if one has been cheated, deceived or has been the victim of betrayal, injustice or snared, then either he has not followed religion properly or misinterpreted it and was not alert. Religion says, be always alert, updated and streamline your all the sources to make you strong enough to protect yourself or not vulnerable to injustice.

Control of senses: There is a myth that religion is too strict on control of senses. The senses mean feelings of eyes, ears, tongue, nose and skin. The happiness means pleasant feelings to senses and to provide it is the objective of religion. The religion allows you to enjoy your life fully which means do anything which is pleasant to your senses but in a balanced way. If there is absolute control on senses then total mankind will be eliminated shortly.

Nature: The sun delivers heat that evaporates water, the water freezes to form ice on mountains or it rains again. The ice again melts due to changing temperatures and forms rivers. The water is again available to human beings and finally the rivers merge into the seas. This natural cycle is repeated again and again. Water flows from high level to low level due to gravitation. The heat generation from the sun is also the result of a natural cycle.

The earth revolves around the sun and this provides us the four seasons. It is also due to the gravitation system of universe. This gravitation itself is also a natural cycle. The moon gives light but it is a reflection of sun's rays, it is also a natural cycle. The sun, moon, seas and the rivers cannot claim for anything. All the natural cycles are the result of a universal system that is created by God. Whatever we have, learned or acquired is belong to this world and thus is given to us by God. Nobody else can claim for anything. That is why the genuine gurus or experts of any subject never claim for anything.

Human acts: Human acts are due to their compulsions of liking or disliking, necessities and genetics. The combined effect of these is human nature or behaviour. All the acts are done due to one's nature. If anyone's act is noticed as good, it is actually to satisfy one's own nature or may be one's duty or to pacify one's inner conflicts. All the human acts are based on the natural cycle, which is created by God. You have not made your mind, nature or yourself, but you are a creation of nature One can improve oneself by utmost sincerity but the capacity or propensity of improvement is again limited by the nature. If you grow an optimum quality of seed of apple in optimum condition and post care, you can have optimum quality of apple but not mango. So no one can claim for his good doings. Everything is given or being offered to us by the natural cycle and once we receive, acquire or act in anyway, we are always monitored by the laws of God.

I: Though everything belong to the nature or God but one cannot say every time that his house, office, cloths, specs etc. belong to God or God has written the books, literature or made each and every article. So for practical reasons and to carryon day today life one has to retain I, my, you, yours, I did, you did, it is mine, it is yours etc.

Spiritualism: Natural laws show us the reasons for all the happenings or actions. Spiritualism prepares us to accept the truths of life. Spiritualism should never be misunderstood as total denial of acts but it is the denial of some of your acts which confuse or deviate you from achieving your goal. Spiritualism is not inactivity but activity in a positive direction in a relatively easy way. Spiritualism is a buffer and will lead you to be stoical. It works the same way as your internal system which helps to maintain your body temperature though outside weather may be hot or cold. Spiritualism helps to subside or normalize your angry, sad, happy, exhilarating etc. moments. It helps you to rationalize your impulsive actions, concentrate your mind and streamline your sources to act in a wise way.
